Cultural Arts Report

The Cultural Arts Program was excited to sponsor a recent week long residency by Leni Newell in Ms. Walker's 6th and 8th grade visual arts classes. The classes made individual batik works during the week of March 30 – April 3. Many thanks to the parent volunteers who helped with the batik process that week! This is the third year Daniels has had Leni Newell come for a residency. Take a look at the banners in the hall outside the gym to see what she and the students have done in prior years.

The week of April 20 – 24 all of the 8th Grade Language Arts classes will have writers-in-residence conduct writing workshops. Daniels is fortunate to host Michael Beadle for another year. Beadle worked with 8th graders last school year and visits from Canton NC where he is both a poet and an award winning journalist. Howard Craft, a playwright and poet from Durham who also teaches at Duke University's Young Writer's Camp will teach a team of Language Arts classes that week. Richard Krawiec will also conduct a workshop, Krawiec is a Raleigh-based author and wrote the Beginning and Intermediate Fiction Curriculum at UNC-Chapel Hill. Each workshop should result in an anthology of the student works and should be an enriching experience for our 8th graders.

In addition to the spring residencies, this past November Capital Opera came to Daniels to perform "Opera 101" to the entire student body. Capital Opera demonstrated to the students how opera is used in the media - from tunes and melodies in television commercials to background music in movies and television shows. All grade levels enjoyed this interactive performance with local opera singers.

Daniels Science Symposium

The March 17 & 18 **DMS SCIENCE SYMPOSIUM** was a great success thanks to efforts from professional community volunteers, DMS staff and students, and DMS parent volunteers! For more than forty years, Daniels Middle School has conducted science symposiums on a regular basis to broaden students' understanding of the importance of science and technology in their lives, and give them an idea of what preparation will be necessary in high school and college to move towards careers in those fields.

On March 17, all 1200 students attended a kick-off assembly to hear Joe Freddoso, president and CEO of the Microelectronics Center of NC, talk about the core traits and skills students need to thrive in an age of constant innovation. The next day, March 18, more than 30 professionals from the community donated a half-day of their valuable time to meet with students in small groups to talk about their careers and demonstrate a variety of scientific principles. The visitors ranged from engineers, to medical doctors, to college professors, to laboratory technicians, and environmental scientists. Discussion topics included construction management, veterinary medicine, space vehicle propulsion, solar water heating, weather monitoring, and more.

"We were excited to host this wonderful public-private partnership for our students in order for them to be exposed to the confluence of science, math and technology in their daily lives and for their future growth", said Dr. Elizabeth Battle, our newly appointed DMS Principal.

Each science class had two opportunities to meet with various speakers and focus on the science behind everyday life. "This is one of the most important events in our school year – parents, teachers and professionals all working together to broaden our students' understanding of the importance of science and math, not only in their lives today but in preparing for the future. We are proud of our long tradition of academic excellence at Daniels and take pleasure in watching our students gain important knowledge in these critical areas of education", said Ms. Susan Cherry, Career Development Coordinator at Daniels.

A special thanks to Daniels staff members, Susan Cherry and Greg Morris, for their dedicated time and efforts towards this successful symposium!

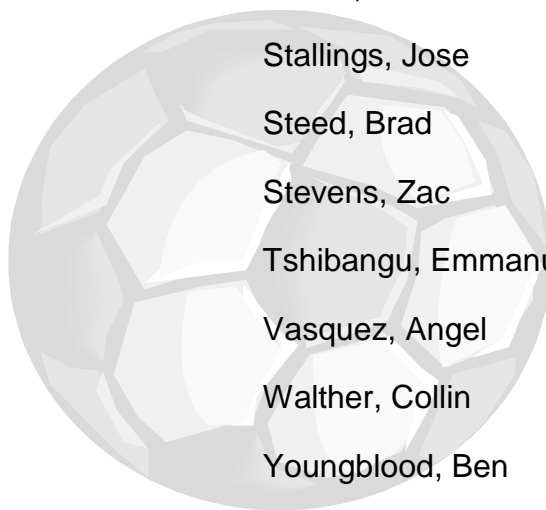

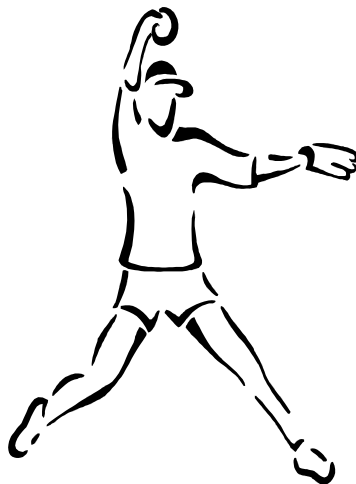
